

## **Individual Child Reports**

F. C. has congenital heart disease and was in very poor health when she first arrived at the



orphanage. She often cried during the day and did not sleep well at night. Since coming to the orphanage, her diet consists of 300 ml of Nestle baby formula given 3-4 times a day. She now loves laughing and being tickled.



This little boy recently came to the orphanage. When he arrived, he was small for his age and was physically very weak. His legs are not developed normally and when he first arrived he got sick easily. Now, thanks to the care he is receiving, he is in much better health and enjoys receiving 300 ml of formula 5-6 times a day.





These beautiful twin girls, born July 23, 2012, were very sickly when they first arrived at Fengcheng and had been hospitalized previously. Thanks to their caregivers, both girls are steadily growing stronger every day and are less prone to illness. They are more lively and happier too. Each day they receive between 120 and 150 ml of formula.



FX is now a little over two years old and suffers from congentital heart disease. When she first came to the orphanage, she started drinking baby formula. She seldom gets sick and with the help of her caretaker is now much healthier. FX is now drinking milk 3-4 times a day and sleeps peacefully through the night.

This two month old boy has a disability in his right ear. He is very intelligent and cries to communicate with his caretaker. When his caretaker picks him up, he stops crying. Each day he drinks 150 ml of formula 5-6 times.
