Total Number of Children: 30 children in foster care and 4 children living at the orphanage.

Altrusa Foundation, working together with Amity Foundation in China, is providing support generalized support at the Fengcheng SWI. We do not sponsor specific children or Hugging Grandmas but instead send periodic donations for specific items. Most often requested is Nestle's formula for the babies and Nestle's powdered milk for the toddlers which we have donated for several times.

Last year we also donated money to buy a washing machine. Before that, laundry for thirty children was done by hand.



The orphanage is requesting donations to buy more powdered formula. This is an important nutritional supplement for the disabled and often malnourished children who live there.

Fengcheng Children That Benefit from Formula & Milk Donations



F.C. is 4 years old and suffers from cerebral palsy and epilepsy. She has a hard time understanding speech, and can make only a few noises. She can grasp objects and move using her walker. She eats four meals a day, including rice cakes, rice, noodles, soup, and Nestles milk.

F.S. is aged 2 years 3 months. Born with retarded growth and suspected cerebral palsy, she cannot yet speak. F.S. has difficultly recognizing when she is called, but can grasp objects and move about in her walker. She eats four meals a day, including rice cakes, rice, noodles, and 480 ml Nestle milk powder.
