1. General Information

- a) **Institute Director:** Director Huang (黄院长)
- b) **Institute Deputy Directors:** Director Rao (饶院长), Director Fang (方院长)
- c) **Head of Amity Foster Care:** Liu Haiyun (刘海芸)- interviews the foster families.
- d) **Amity Physician (Grandma):** Zhu Tianfeng (朱天芬)
- e) **Number of Children:** The Institute has 15 children living in it, while Amity sponsors six children for foster care.
- f) **Physical Exam and Vaccination Protocols:** The foster children are given monthly physical exams in their homes. Foster mothers bring their children to the local epidemic prevention center for vaccinations.

2. Overall Impression

The Hengfeng Social Welfare Institute (SWI) currently has fifteen children and nine children in foster care. Some of the children in the Institute are healthy, while others are disabled. The children live in three rooms with three staffers to take care of them.

c) Visited Amity Grandma Zhu Tianfen, the Institute physician.



During the spring, the children easily get sick with various small problems. In the photo above Doctor Zhu is in the process of examining all of the children to make sure they are healthy. She is very familiar with each child's health situation and is able to effectively administer any vaccinations or medicines necessary. Doctor Zhu loves the children very much and when she is not doctoring, she will also tickle them or hold them. The children all enjoy this very much and love being held! Although there are not many children in the institute Doctor Zhu comes each day to help care for them and is dedicated to volunteering.
