Number of Children: The orphanage has 22 children, of which Amity sponsors six children for foster care; others are living in the orphanage.

Physical Exam and Vaccination Protocols: The foster children are given monthly physical exams in their homes. Foster mothers bring their children to the local epidemic prevention center for vaccinations.

In the year of 2012, 13 children were adopted by foreign families while 13 by Chinese. 2 have been adopted by Chinese in 2013.

There are four rooms in the Hengfeng SWI, each equipped with one nurse taking care of children. Most of the children I saw last year were adopted so that I saw many new children who are younger than one-year-old.
