Special Ed



This cutie is reported to be normal mentally but has disability of his legs and as a result of surgery on his spine he is incontinent and so foster families haven't been willing to care for him. He has had his papers in for international adoption for a long time but has not yet been adopted.

### **Sponsoring Nursing Education**

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DJ, a girl we started sponsoring for nursing school this year, came to tell us thank you for her support. She lives at the orphanage and takes the public bus to school (see below for picture of front of school). She has mild CP which affects one side so she would not be able to do some nursing jobs so she is focusing on "rehab" and would like to work as a nurse for the orphanage when she is finished her 3 year program. Long discussion was held about this because it is hard to be a "formal" employee which means your salary and benefits are paid by the government instead of employees hired from the orphanage fund where the salaries are lower.



#### **Fabulous Foster Parents**

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AY (with Down's Syndrome) is the girl in the yellow coat. She is in her third year of kindergarten and the SWI is not sure what she will do next, hopefully they can enroll her in a special ed school.

AY's Foster Mom (FM1) is the mother of ALN's (red coat) Foster Mom (FM2), however, because FM2's husband is in the hospital FM1 is caring for both children.

> She (FM1) has fostered four other children in the past that have all been adopted. Apparently ALN will be adopted soon. She is smart but very quiet, a "good child" and they proudly report she can eat a bowl of porridge. Foster Mom did put ALN down some to show us how she could walk (in her split bottom pants).



#### **Fabulous Foster Parents**

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Foster home of AJ and ALJ (to be adopted soon) in Qing Shan district. They live in the top floor apartment seen below.

AJ (red sweater, plaid coat) has Down Syndrome. His papers have been turned in for special needs adoption and the director took him to an event in Fuzhou promoting special needs adoption. He is also in his third year of kindergarten and hopefully can go to a special ed school next year.

ALJ (blue coat) has had surgery on both her heart and another birth defect. Her heart disease was severe so she had to have surgery in Beijing last year instead of in Nanchang. Her foster mother went to Beijing with her to take care of her for the month she was in the hospital. While she was gone the foster father took care of AJ and the foster mother's mother also helped.

These two kids like to go to the community center nearby in their apartment complex most evenings and dance with the music

The foster father works in the coal mine and their daughter is in boarding school.

They have fostered approximately 10 kids before these AJ and ALJ and "they regard the children very well" and care for them like they are their own. The neighbors also regard the children warmly.

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HDP at her foster home.

She has CP and is not able to attend school. Although her intelligence is probably near normal and she seems to understand very well when people talk to her, she is only able to say a few words and often makes her desires known with gestures.

She can feed herself but is very messy so sometimes her foster mom feeds her.

Her foster mom is concerned because as she grows she is getting too heavy for the foster mom to bath (and 'this is a job the foster father can't do").

HDP can push herself around in the wheelchair with one foot and likes being outside (flat cement area).

The foster parent's son lives next door and bought HDP the clothes she has on as well as some others. The neighbors also donate clothing.
