

Wanzai Social Welfare Institute Report: January 9, 2012

General Information

- a) **Institute Director:** Li Longhui
- b) **Institute Vice-Directors:** Xin Xiaoping, Ceng Duanfa, Vice-Director Wu
- c) **Amity Foster Care Directors:** Vice-Director Wu, Tan Mei, Ceng Xiuying.
- d) **Number of Children:** There are about twenty children in the Institute and six Amity foster children. In total, there are about thirty children.
- e) **Physical Exam and Vaccination Protocols:** Each month the directors visit the families about two or three times. Once a month, they do physical exams and administer vaccinations.

Overall Impression

The number of children at the Wanzai Social Welfare Institute is smaller than before. There are currently six children sponsored by the Amity Foundation who are in foster homes. Most of the children who live in the SWI are physically disabled, some with Cerebral Palsy, mentally retarded, cleft lip and palates, congenital heart disease, etc. It has been difficult to find suitable foster families for the children because they need a lot of care. Some of the children who need extra care receive it from the Institute staff, and they also have the opportunity to learn basic knowledge and everyday skills.
