AMITY/ALTRUSA ASSIST WANZAI SWI


Wanzai SWI began international adoptions in 1992 and to date, approximately 500 adoptions have been processed. They started working with Amity in 2000, benefitting about 60 children with long term foster care and schooling. Wanzai has received 460,000 yuan from Amity. Approximately 60,000 yuan was received for education especially for the older children and the blind children. Two of the blind children graduated from school and now have jobs working as a masseuse. Two others in the program with Hepatitis B, one who also had poor vision, were adopted.

Currently, Wanzai has about 70 children in their care, ages 0-20. Most children are under the age of 10 and have disabilities. They receive 1000 yuan per month from the government which pays for their basic living expenses, but many need long term rehabilitative care. Some

children have gone to the Nanchang SWI rehab center for 2-3 months but still need longer rehab services. Jiangxi civil affairs is establishing four other rehab centers in orphanages around the province which may be open in 2014. These may be at Yichun, Fuzhou, Jiujiang and Ruijin.

About 10 children live in the orphanage, 6 are at the Nanchang rehab center, 6 are sponsored in foster care by Altrusa/Amity and the remaining children are in foster care paid by the orphanage.

Many older foster moms are
Grandmas in the family and the younger
generation isn't interested in being foster
parents because they can get a job and
earn more money. So as these older foster
moms have to quit fostering (often for
health reasons) it becomes increasingly
difficult to find new foster homes for the
children. The new Children's Building that
is under construction for a May 2014
opening will have two apartments for
"group homes" where about 6 children will
live with foster parents in each apartment.

WL IS A 4 YEAR OLD GIRL THAT HAS AUTISM AND COGNITIVE IMPAIRMENT.



WJ IS AN 11 YEAR OLD GIRL THAT HAS CP AND CONGENITAL DEMENTIA. SHE HAS BEEN WITH THIS FOSTER MOM SINCE SHE WAS A BABY. EVEN THOUGH IT'S HARDER TO CARE FOR HER BECAUSE SHE'S BIGGER, THE FOSTER MOM LOVES HER SO MUCH THAT SHE WANTS TO CONTINUE FOSTERING HER.



WL (PINK) IS A 3 YEAR OLD GIRL WITH CP AND SOME COGNITIVE IMPAIRMENT. WJ (BLUE) IS A 9 YEAR OLD BOY WHO HAS SOME COGNITIVE IMPAIRMENT. HE HAS BEEN WITH THIS VERY EXPERIENCED FOSTER MOM FOR 2 YEARS.



WL'S LEFT SIDE IS AFFECTED WITH A DROOPY EYELID AND SOME WEAKNESS OF HER LEFT ARM AND LEG WHICH HAS IMPROVED SOME. SHE IS ALSO NOT ABLE TO CONTROL HER BOWELS. SHE CAN SAY A FEW WORDS AND POINT TO BODY PARTS WHEN QUESTIONED.

NEW APARTMENTS

WJ'S FOSTER HOME IS IN AN AREA OF FAIRLY NEW APARTMENTS. YOU CAN SEE THAT THE HOME HE'S IN IS NEW AND WELL-KEPT.

THE APARTMENTS WERE BUILT FOR FARMERS WHO WERE DISPLACED FROM THEIR HOMES AND FARMLAND BECAUSE OF CITY DEVELOPMENT PROJECTS. SO THE GOVERNMENT GIVES THE FAMILIES THESE APARTMENTS TO LIVE IN. OFTEN THESE FAMILIES HAVE MORE TIME TO BE FOSTER PARENTS BECAUSE THEY ARE NO LONGER WORKING ON THE FARM.
